Watering by-law: for responsible management of drinking water!

Manual watering of vegetation

Manual watering is permitted at all times for a garden, a vegetable patch, a flower box, a planter, a flower bed, a tree and a shrub.

New lawn and new landscaping

It is permitted to water every day for a period of 15 days following seeding, planting or installation of sod, according to the hours specified in the by-law.

Lawn watering hours

Lawn watering is permitted according to the following schedule:



Prevention visits

The Fire Safety Department's day team is now out for prevention visits throughout the City. Monday to Friday, between 9 am and 4 pm. They are always well identified, easy to recognize and always travel with City vehicles. If you miss their visit, the Service will leave a document. It is important to answer the questions of said document and follow the instructions in order to send it to the Fire Safety Department. We thank you for your cooperation!

Burning permit (with control)

Please note that a burning permit is required for outdoor fires. The authorized fires are: fire of dry hay, straw, grass, pile of wood, brushwood, branches, and abattis fire. Before issuing the permit, a member of the Fire Safety Department will visit the site to check on safety. How and where to report a problem?

The Public Works Department receives and treats requests from citizens who wish to participate in the resolution of a problem. Wrongly, some people believe that the fastest way is to send a message by Facebook Messenger, contact the councilor of their district, or even to inform their neighbor who is a city employee. In fact, these procedures are complicating the normal process of a request since we must verify that the request has not already been received, and follow up via a third party.

For greater efficiency, we ask all citizens to use the communication tools in place to send a request. Processing will be faster and you will also have direct follow-up with our teams.

Download the VOILA! mobile app on your mobile device. Locate the problem, take a picture, and your query will be forwarded.

Collections and moving season

The RIADM provides the blue and brown bins free of charge, one of each color per address. Those bins are the property of the RIADM and must stay on site for the next occupant.

The green bin belongs to the occupant or owner and it is his responsibility to buy one. Note that said bin has to be compatible with collection trucks. So if you move, it can follow you to your new address unless it belongs to your landlord.





Are you moving into a new building?

For any new construction, the RIADM provides the new building with a green bin for garbage collection. For information, you must contact the RIADM at 450 562-3786 (extension 1).

For a complaint concerning a problem with a collection or a broken green bin: Town Hall | 450-533-6687 (ext. 0). For a replacement or for a broken blue or brown bin: RIADM | 450-562-3786 (ext. 1).

IMPORTANT REMINDER:

Position your bins correctly in your driveway entrance; in order to facilitate the work of the collection trucks, place the bins with the wheels towards the residence.

REPORT AN NON-URGENT ISSUE IN YOUR CITY :



The VOILA! app makes it easy to report a problem in your municipality such as potholes, broken streetlights, graffiti, etc. The citizens can thus participate in solving problems in their neighborhood.

1 | LOCATE IT Target on the map with the geolocation or enter the civic address near the problem. 1 | PHOTOGRAPH IT Select the nature of the problem from a predefined list, add a description and then take a picture of it. 1 | SEND IT VOILÀ! sends your request to your municipality for you.
